At this juncture, I would like to throw light on our Display Board highlighting the theme of our Samskruthik Utsav-which means celebrations associated with our culture and tradition. Here ,we

have used jalli stones to reinforce the value of being with nature emphasizing on culminating art and creativity with aesthetic blend of usage of natural resources. We are very happy to inform you that our students secured 100 percent result in Secondary and senior secondary exam conducted by CBSE..

- ❖ The in service training program for teachers commenced from May 29 to June 6 were in teachers where given the training to keep themselves abreast with the new technologies and understanding the psychology of children.
- ❖ School reopened after the summer break for KG sections to Class IX on 10.06.2024.
- ❖ International yoga day was celebrated on June 21 by giving awareness on the importance of yoga in bringing tranquility in our life.
- ❖ Investiture ceremony of School Pupil leader, Assistant school people leader, Captains, vice captains and Prefects was conducted on June 29th.
- ❖ Inservice training programme was conducted by the subject expert for the teaching and non teaching staff and students on POCSO AND POSH awareness.
- ❖ Awareness on environmental conservation and conservation of nature was undertaken during the months of June and July on this year's theme Beat plastic pollution.

- ❖ 14th August marked the observation of Partition Horror's Remembrance day showcasing the sacrifices of great freedom fighters and their struggle.
- ❖ Independence Day- Independence Day was celebrated with pomp and fervor by the active participation of the entire Siddharth family members. The day started with welcoming of the chief guest followed by the march past of the four houses and display of various cultural and traditional performances and reinstilling the spirit of Patriotism and Unity in each one of us
- ❖ Teachers Day celebration was a very special event where in all the students joined together to put up a pompous show to exhibit the love and affection to their teachers by gifting each one of us with a precious handmade greeting card and presenting cultural events.
- ❖ In accordance with the CBSE initiative the school also conducted swachh Bharat activities and swachata pakhwada activities.
- ❖ CBSE reading challenge activities were conducted according to the grades in CBSE reading app.
- ❖ To Remember and pay tribute to the father of our nation, swachatahi seva activities and Shramdaan activities were undertaken on the occasion of Gandhi Jayanti Gandhi Jayanti
- ❖ Mental health awareness week was observed from 4th October to 10th October where in students were assigned with various tasks like appreciating their friends, writing thank you cards, putting up positivity boards etc to instill positivity in each one of us.
- ❖ Vigilance awareness week was celebrated from 30 October to 4th November to bring awareness among students regarding the promotion of transparency, probity and integrity in public life as they are the future citizens of the country. Students undertook a pledge to be vigilant about their rights and to check corruption at every level.
- ❖ 31st of October marked the observance of Rashtriya Ekta Diwas-Run for Unity.
- ❖ Eco friendly Diwali celebration- Awareness programmes were conducted on celebrating eco friendly Diwali from 3rd November to 10th November. The students of classes 6 to 12 gave awareness program in the morning assembly to impart the sense of Civic responsibility by making the children understand the ill effects of bursting crackers and also suggesting ways to celebrate eco friendly Diwali. All the students joined together and contributed rice , oil,

sugar, lentils, nuts, sweets, groceries, fruits and other essentials to 4 orphanages in and around Hosur.

- ❖ The Central Board of Secondary Education organised regional level science exhibition at Chennai on 15 and 16 November. Our school presented a project titled Peel to power ie extracting bio ethanol from banana peel under the theme Waste management.

This year too our students won laurels by getting gold medal of Excellence at the Olympiad examinations conducted by the Science Olympiad Foundation.
